

Contest Name: **Bartender of the Month** (herein defined as the "Contest")

Station(s): WMMS-FM, WAKS-FM (herein defined as the "Station")

Clear Channel Broadcasting, Inc., its subsidiaries and affiliated companies (together, the "Company"), will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

The Company may conduct the Contest concurrently and simultaneously on several participating radio stations owned and not owned by the Company, and in various States, and the Company may add or remove participating stations or change call letters of any participating station at any time during the Contest as announced on the affected station. Participating stations are listed above.

1. Description of Contest/Participation.

A. Dates of Contest: The Contest will begin on Monday, January 12th 2009 and end on or about Monday, December 23rd, 2009.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING. Void where prohibited. Odds of winning depend upon the number of participants.

B. How to Enter:

1. Beginning Monday, January 12th, 2009 log onto the Station's website at www.wmms.com, www.kisscleveland.com (keyword: BARTENDER) and/or follow the Contest links to register. Deadline for online registration is 11:59 p.m. on November 24, 2009.

Valid contest entries must contain all information requested. Incomplete and/or multiple entries will not be accepted. Photos must be submitted along with Bartender's Name, Phone, and reason why nominated.

C. Voting Period:

Beginning on or around February 2, 2009 the station will invite listeners to vote for the Bartender of the Month, based on the criteria listed below. Deadline to vote is at noon for each month: February 23rd, March 23rd, April 23rd, May 23rd, June 23rd, July 23rd, August 24th, September 23rd, October 23rd, November 24th and December 23rd, 2009. After each voting period, there will be only one winner, and the remaining contestants will be included in the next voting round.

Judging criteria voters should use for the contest is based on the following:

- Originality of Photo
- Personality
- Photo quality
- Reason why they should win

Voting is limited to one vote per verified email address. If an entrant receives multiple and/or irregular votes or multiple votes from the same user or users, including but not limited to, votes generated by a robotic, programmed, script, macro, other automated means or other source, the Station reserves the right to disqualify the finalist in its sole discretion.

D. How to Win:

At the conclusion of the voting period, the Station will select the Bartender of the Month based on the photos which received the most votes. If there is a tie, the Station will select a panel of judges to select the Bartender of the Month based on the judging criteria, listed above. All decisions of the judges will be final.

2. Prize(s). The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) are:

1. 1 Year Worth of Tanning from TNT Tanning
2. 1 Year Supply of Vitamin Water
3. ServSafe Certification

Prizes valued at \$1,744. Prizes are not transferable, or exchangeable for any other prize. All prizes must be picked up within 60 days of the contest end date. If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified, the Company reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion.

3. Eligibility and Limitations. Participants and winner(s) must be U.S. residents 21 years of age or older as determined by the Company, reside in the state of Ohio and possess a valid Ohio Drivers License. The Company reserves the right to refuse to award a prize to or on behalf of any minor. Only one (1) entry per person. Only one (1) prize per household for the Contest. Only one (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of the Company, the Contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related. All other standard Clear Channel contest rules apply.

By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Company, its employees and agents, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. In order to receive a prize, participants must sign an official waiver form provided by the Company.

7. Taxes. Any valuation of the prize(s) stated above is based on available information provided to the Company, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law.
